



# **Pell Horse**

Our pellets (small cylinders of compressed wood) are made from 100% pine reforested and implanted forests. Obtained from the pressing and heating process, mixing all wood substances to produce a resistant pellet, bacteria and dust free.

The advantages of the wood pellets are not only economic; you will simplify the cleaning process of the boxes and stalls. Increase efficiency and reduce labor, highly absorbent "Pell Horse" wood pellet bedding causes liquid waste to clump together, allowing for easier removal.

Manure piles grow at a slower pace –as much as 50 percent slower than with other bedding options.

Unlike straw and wood shavings, our wood pellets do not expire and always have the same quality at an affordable price.



# Horse Bedding Instruccions

To make a 2-4 inch (5-10 cm) bed in an approximately 10'x 10' (3x3 meters) box, it takes about 10 bags of 33 pounds (15 kg) of Pell Horse.

Incorporate 5 pre-soaked bags and repeat the process with the 5 more bags. To moisten just spray 1.5 gallons (5 liters) of water on each bag, so a soft but very absorbent bed is created.

Once built, to maintain the level of the bed, you only need to spread one bag (previously soaked) on top of the bed every one to two weeks. A pellet bed should last a minimum of eight weeks.

# All benefits

#### MORE ABSORBENT:

The pellet absorbs up to 4 times more than shavings or straw. It also has a very low moisture level, between 6 and 10%, with a long last duration in perfect condition before being removed.

# ODOR CONTROL:

The pellet neutralizes the urines ammonia, which means a significantly reduce of unpleasant odors and the possibility of respiratory disease in horses. By reducing the odors, it also reduces the appearance of the always annoying flies.

# • STORES IN LESS SPACE:

The pellet is much denser than the wood shavings so it requires less storage space. In addition, since it's more absorbent, beds do not require a rapid stall strip as the wood shavings, so the cleaning time of the block is reduced by half.

# • REDUCE MAINTENANCE COST:

Once the beds are built you just have to remove the manure and proceed as indicated in the instructions. And the horse bedding cost will be reduced up to 75%.

In addition to lower maintenance costs and bed building time, cleaning time is reduced in half of the time.
